Friday, July 4:	INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY. CITY OFFICES CLOSED. NO PICKUP OF HOUSHOLD WASTES.

THERE'LL BE NO CHANGE TO THE RECYCLING PICKUP SCHEDULE.
