1. HOLIDAYS. In December and early January, the City offices with be CLOSED on the following days: from noon on Thursday, December 24th; all day on Friday, Christmas Day, December 25th; and all day on Friday, New Year's Day, January 1st. These holidays will change the City's garbage/trash pickup schedule as follows:

C. Friday, January 1st, New Year's Day: NO SERVICE. Residents who usually receive service on Friday will have service on THURSDAY, DECEMBER 31st.

For both holidays, there'll be no change to the pickup schedule for recyclables and for yard trash/special waste.
