
WORKSHOPS

American Flag Rescue Program

The American Flag Rescue (AFR) program was initiated in 2019 after St. Johns County Solid Waste Management staff observed worn and damaged American flags in drop-off garbage containers at the Tillman Ridge facility. Although some flag collection containers already were in place in several stores that sell American flags, more collection points were clearly needed. The initial shipment of new flag collection boxes was funded by local radio personality Kevin Geddings. These units were placed in St. Johns County libraries. Of the nearly 1,000 flags collected in 2020, about 10% were reusable and these are available to the public. Damaged flags are retired according to established protocols by local Scout troops and veteran's organizations. An American Flag booklet provided by Supervisor of Elections Vicky Oakes is also available. 

Individuals who are 65 years of age or are healthcare providers with direct patient contact and are interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccine may preregister for an appointment by visiting <https://sjcvaccineappointment.sjcfl.us>. Those who preregister will receive an automated phone call from 904.295.3711 with an assigned appointment date and time. Individuals who choose to decline the appointment will remain preregistered, and will receive a subsequent phone call with an alternative appointment. Upon arrival at the vaccination site, appointment holders will be required to provide proof of age or healthcare employment, and proof of Florida residency. The appointment preregistration system is only for

individuals who are receiving their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Please call 904.295.3711 for additional information, or to request assistance with preregistration.

With Spring and summer here, many of you have questions about watering your lawn and gardens. Hopefully, this will help with some of the more frequently asked questions.

When Can I Water My Lawn?

- No one can water from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The sun is simply too hot at that time of day and the water evaporates too quickly to be of much use.
- During daylight saving (spring forward): Odd-numbered addresses can water on Wednesday and Saturdays and even-numbered addresses can water on Thursdays and Sundays.
