Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!

Curbside Recycling RESUMES on January 3, 2022.

Thanks to the City of St. Augustine for providing the temporary dumpster and services!



Dear St. Augustine Beach Resident, The City of St. Augustine Beach is pleased

to announce that curbside recycling services will resume on **January 3, 2022**.

- City of SAB ONLY ACCEPTABLE items:
- · Type 1 and 2 Plastics
- · Steel and Aluminum Cans
- Paper and Cardboard

Other items placed in bins will result in the bins not being emptied. Bins not emptied will be tagged with an explanation of cause.



City of SAB NOT ACCEPTABLE items:

- Plastic Bags of any type
- . Glass of any type
- . Cartons Milk, Juice etc.
- Fast Food Bags
- Pizza Boxes
- Plastics other than Type 1 or 2 e.g. Yogurt Containers, Pill Bottles, Plastic Wraps, Styrofoam, etc.
- · Aluminium Foil or Baking Serving Dishes

Each dwelling unit is entitled to two [2] 18 gallon City issued recycling bins.

If you do not have an 18 gallon City issued bin, please contact City Hall at [904] 471-2122.


IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Your **recycling** pick-up day will be the **SAME** as your **trash** pick-up day.

The city is only collecting the city issued blue 18 gallon bins. Recyclables put in any type of closed container, large or small, will NOT be picked up.


Recycled items should be LOOSE in the bins, not in a plastic bag or any other type of bag. Bagged items will not be picked up.

Dumpsters at City Hall will remain available through December 31, 2021.



American Flag Rescue Program

The American Flag Rescue (AFR) program was initiated in 2019 after St. Johns County Solid Waste Management staff observed worn and damaged Americans flags in drop-off garbage containers at the Tillman Ridge facility. Although some flag collection containers already were in place in several stores that sell American flags, more collection points were clearly needed. The initial shipment of new flag collection boxes was funded by local radio personality Kevin Geddings. These units were placed in St. Johns County libraries. Of the nearly 1,000 flags collected in 2020, about 10% were reusable and these are available to the public. Damaged flags are retired according to established protocols by local Scout troops and veteran's organizations. An American Flag booklet provided by Supervisor of Elections Vicky Oakes is also available. 
